



2008 Leonard P. Rome CATCH Visiting Professorships Program

The Leonard P. Rome Community Access to Child Health (CATCH) Visiting Professorships Program promotes advocacy for children and advances the field of community pediatrics. This program was established in honor of Leonard P. Rome, MD, a pediatrician and tireless child health advocate who dedicated his life to improving children's health. Pediatric residency programs are eligible to receive up to \$4,500 each to fund a 2-or 3-day educational program focusing on the field of community pediatrics.

The 6 programs approved for funding in 2008 are:

Orlando Regional Healthcare – Arnold Palmer Hospital for Children – Orlando, FL

Pediatric Residency Program of Children's Hospital of Orange County – Orange, CA

University of Buffalo Pediatric Residency Program – Buffalo, NY

University of Virginia Department of Pediatrics – Charlottesville, VA

University of Washington / Children's Hospital and Regional Medical Center – Seattle, WA
