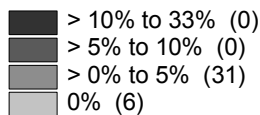
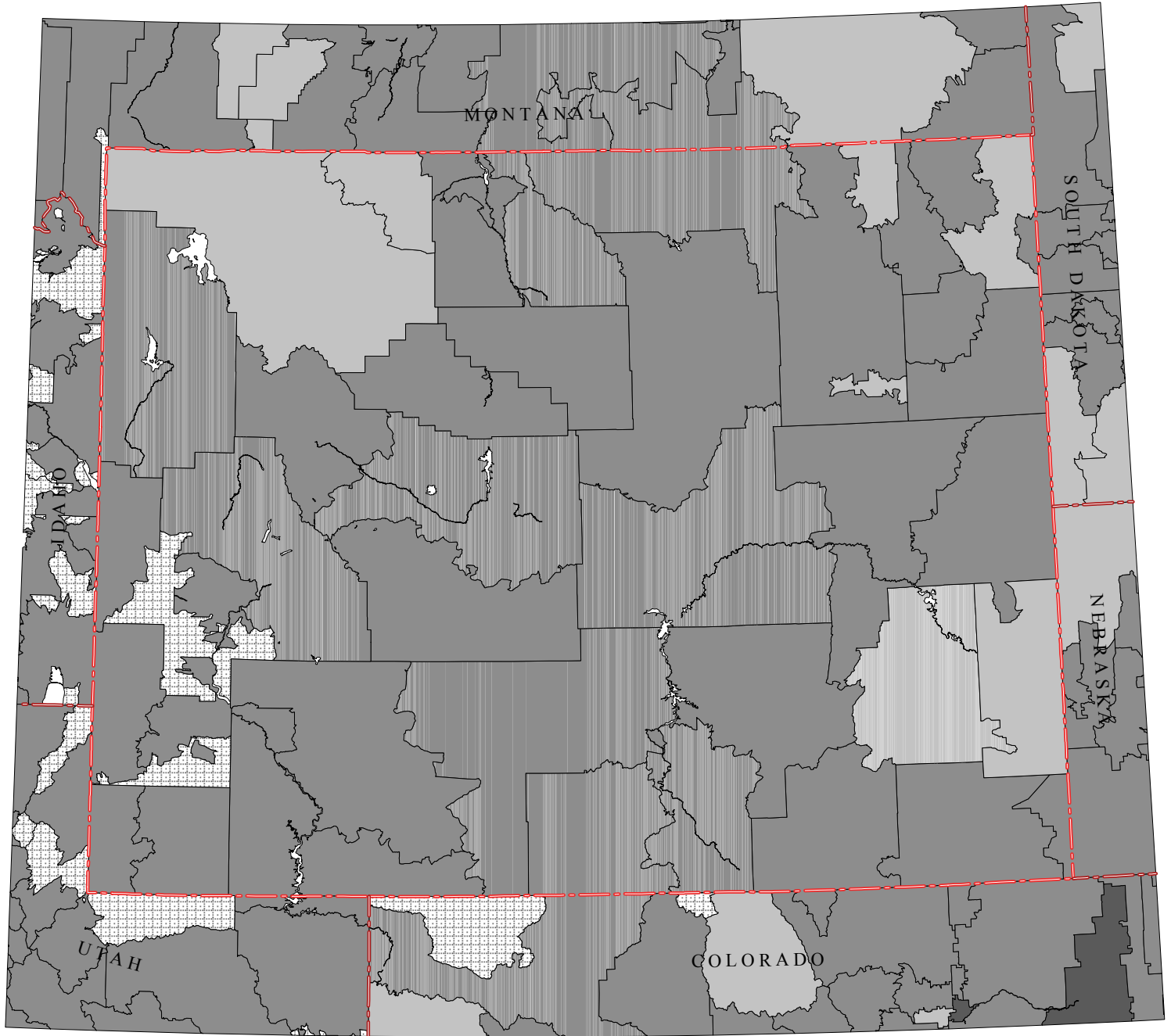


# Wyoming Primary Care Service Areas
