- 1) Must be certified as Physiatrists by the American Board of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.
- 2) Must spend a minimum of 50% of their current practice, research and teaching time devoted to children and adolescents with disabilities **and**

OPTION 1

- 1) Must hold a subspecialty certificate in Pediatric Rehabilitation Medicine from the American Board of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation **and/or**

OPTION 2

- 1) Must have completed a Fellowship in Pediatric Rehabilitation following a residency in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.
- 2) Candidates must submit copies of their diplomas as evidence of their fellowship training.

Applicants must submit:

- Copies of their diplomas as evidence of their fellowship training.
- Completed application form and any necessary fees.
