## **SECTION AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP**

### **Qualifications:**

1. Licensed physicians and pharmacists not eligible for AAP national membership who have completed at least 1 year of postgraduate training in an area of pediatric therapeutics and devote at least 50% of their professional time to the care of children; **or**
2. Licensed physicians and pharmacists who have satisfied all requirements of the American Board of Clinical Pharmacology (ABCP) and earned either the CP certificate (certified in clinical pharmacology) or AP certificate (accredited in applied pharmacology) credential consistent with Diplomate status in the ABCP; **or**
3. Physicians with an interest in pediatric pharmacology and devote at least 50% of their professional time to any aspect of pediatric therapeutics (eg regulatory, drug development, research, toxicology, poison control, etc.)

### **Applicants must submit:**

- Completed application
- Current CV or Resume
- Copy of degree or training certificate
- Copy of current license
