2. Specialty Fellows

Special Requirements:

Must be child psychiatrists boarded in General Psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology who spend a minimum of 50% of their professional activities devoted to the care of infants, children, and adolescents through age 21.

Applicants must submit:

- A letter of support from an AAP member in good standing.
- Completed application form and any necessary fees.

SECTION AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

Qualifications:

1. International Members **OR**
2. Certain allied health professionals, including psychiatrists, psychologists, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, speech and language pathologists, occupational and physical therapists, social workers, educators, and international physicians not otherwise eligible for Academy membership who spend a minimum of 50% of their professional time working with developmental and behavioral problems in children.

Applicants must submit:

- Current CV
- Copy of current license in the relevant profession
- Completed application form and any necessary fees.
