2. Registered nurses, nurse clinicians, clinical nurse specialists, hematology/oncology nurses, nurse practitioners, and physicians assistants who are demonstrably active in pediatric hematology/oncology
3. Psychologists and social workers that are demonstrably active in pediatric hematology/oncology.

### **Special Requirements:**

- \* These professionals must be a part of a pediatric hematology/oncology team under the direct supervision of a certified pediatric hematologist/oncologist within a pediatric hematology/oncology department or division with at least 50% of their time devoted to the care of infants, children, and adolescents with hematological/oncological diseases.
