

PLASTIC SURGERY

SECTION MEMBERSHIP

This Section welcomes the following Member types:

1. Post-Residency Training members

Special Requirements:

- Must be pursuing further subspecialty training in pediatric plastic surgery, pediatric cranio-maxillofacial surgery, pediatric microsurgery, or pediatric burns.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees

2. Candidate members

Special Requirements:

- Must have completed their training and have entered clinical practice, but may have not yet attained American Board of Plastic Surgery or Royal College of Surgeons of Canada membership, or may not have resided in a single locale for 18 months.
- A minimum of 50% of professional time must be devoted to the care of infants, children, and adolescents through age 21.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees

3. Specialty Fellows

Special Requirements:

- Certification by the American Board of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in plastic surgery.
- Residence in the same locale for 18 months prior to the application.
- A minimum of 50% of clinical practice must be devoted to the care of infants, children, and adolescents through age 21.

Applicants must submit:

- Photocopy of your certificate(s) of board certification
- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- Sponsor letters from:
 - (a) Two members of the AAP Section on Plastic Surgery, one of whom resides in the state or region of the applicant and is familiar with the applicant's work in pediatric plastic surgery.
 - (b) One AAP Fellow (pediatrician) residing in the same locale as the applicant.

SECTION AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

Qualifications:

1. Licensed plastic surgeons not eligible for Specialty Fellowship in the AAP who reside outside the United States and Canada and who devote 50% of their time to pediatric plastic surgery patients.
2. Registered nurses, speech pathologists, physical and occupational therapists, or social workers who devote at least 50% of their time to pediatric surgery patients.
3. Research scientists with a Masters or PhD degree who devote at least 50% of their research time to conditions related to pediatric plastic surgery.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
