SECTION AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

1. Physicians not eligible for membership in the Academy, whose practice or research includes the interfacility transport of pediatric patients.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees.

2. Nurses whose clinical practice, research, or administrative responsibilities include the interfacility transport of pediatric patients.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- A copy of their nursing license.

3. Respiratory care practitioners whose clinical practice, research, or administrative responsibilities include the interfacility transport of pediatric patients.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- A copy of their state license (or documentation from a supervisor that licensure is not available in their state) and proof of certification or registration by the National Board of Respiratory Care.

4. Paramedics (EMT-P's) whose clinical practice, research, or administrative responsibilities include the interfacility transport of pediatric patients.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- A copy of licensure by their state or by the National Registry of EMT-P's.

5. Physician assistants (PAs) whose clinical practice, research, or administrative responsibilities include the interfacility transport of pediatric patients.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- A copy of their state license.

6. Neonatal/pediatric transport administrators who have direct responsibility for the overall management (fiscal, personnel, etc.) of a neonatal and/or pediatric inter-facility transport team.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form and any necessary fees
- A current CV
- One letter of support from a Section member.
