MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

RESIDENT MEMBER

Enrolled in a residency program approved for credit toward board certification by American Board of Pediatrics (ABP), American Osteopathic Board of Pediatrics (AOBP), Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or La Corporation Professionnelle des Medecins du Quebec.

POST-RESIDENCY TRAINING MEMBER

Fellow of a post-residency training program leading to pediatric subspecialty. You can move into this category from the Resident, Candidate or Fellow categories.

CANDIDATE MEMBER

Completed residency and is eligible for board certification exam in a board or specialty board that meets Fellow or Specialty Fellow requirements.

FELLOW, FAAP

Board-certified pediatrician by one of the boards named under Resident.
Discount off first-years dues.

Discounted Dues Options

Married Fellow—Available to Fellows or Specialty Fellows married to a Fellow or Specialty Fellow

Dual Membership—Available to specific member types who are members of the American College of Physicians (ACP) or the Canadian Paediatric Society (CPS)

Medical Missionary—Available to Fellows and Candidates working more than 9 months of the fiscal year on a project or program located outside of the United States and Canada

Leave of Absence—Available to Fellows requesting 1-year leave for no more than 2 consecutive years

RETIRED FELLOW, FAAP

AAP Fellow for at least 5 years, 55 years old, fully retired from practice.

EMERITUS FELLOW, FAAP

AAP Fellow for 30 years, and 65 years old.

SPECIALTY FELLOW, FAAP

Board certified by boards other than pediatric, but practice is 50% or greater in treating infants, children, adolescents, or young adults. All Specialty Fellows must meet the criteria and join the AAP Section specific to their specialty.

CORRESPONDING FELLOW, FAAP

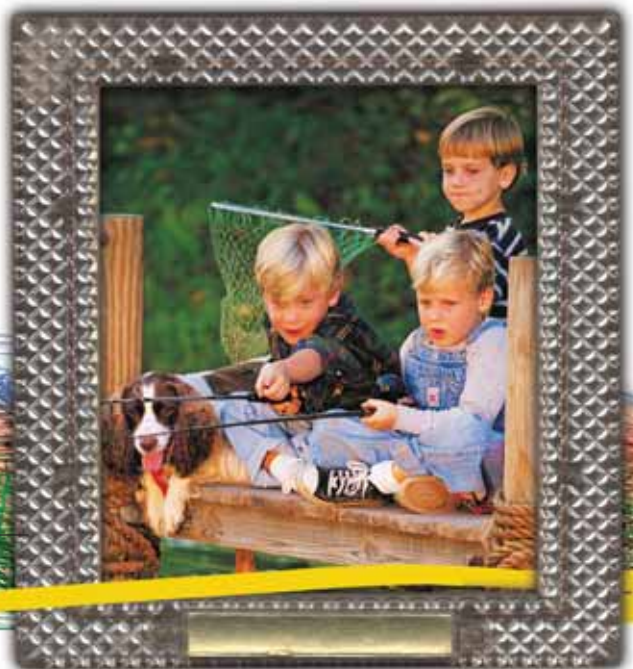
A Fellow or Specialty Fellow living and practicing in a country other than U.S., Canada, or Puerto Rico. Special rates for Corresponding Fellows.

INTERNATIONAL MEMBER

Doctor of Medicine and is board-certified in pediatrics in a country other than United States, Canada, or Puerto Rico and is a member of their local pediatric society.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Certified in pediatric dentistry from a program accredited by the Council on Accreditation of the American Dental Association and practice in United States, Canada, or Puerto Rico.
