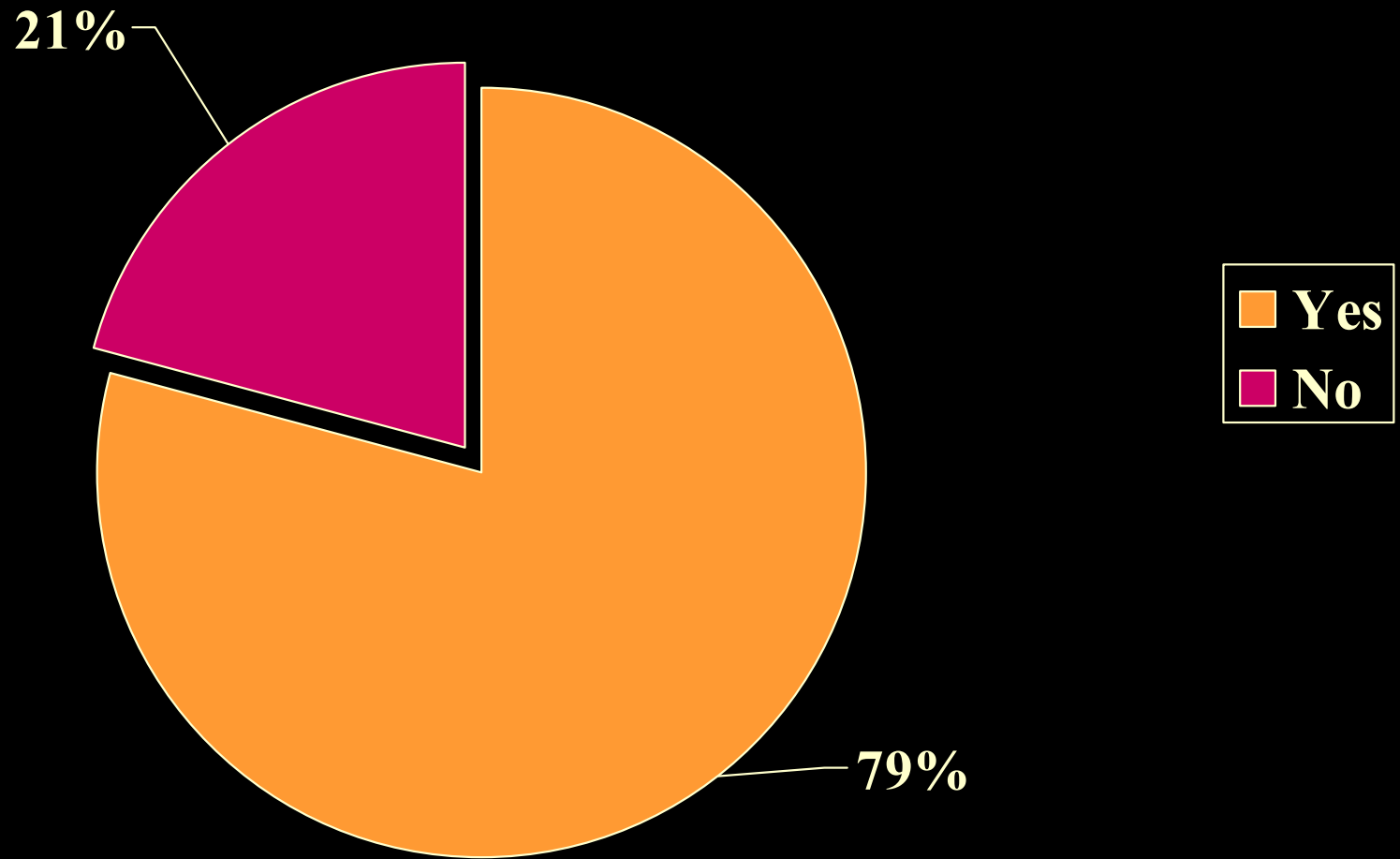

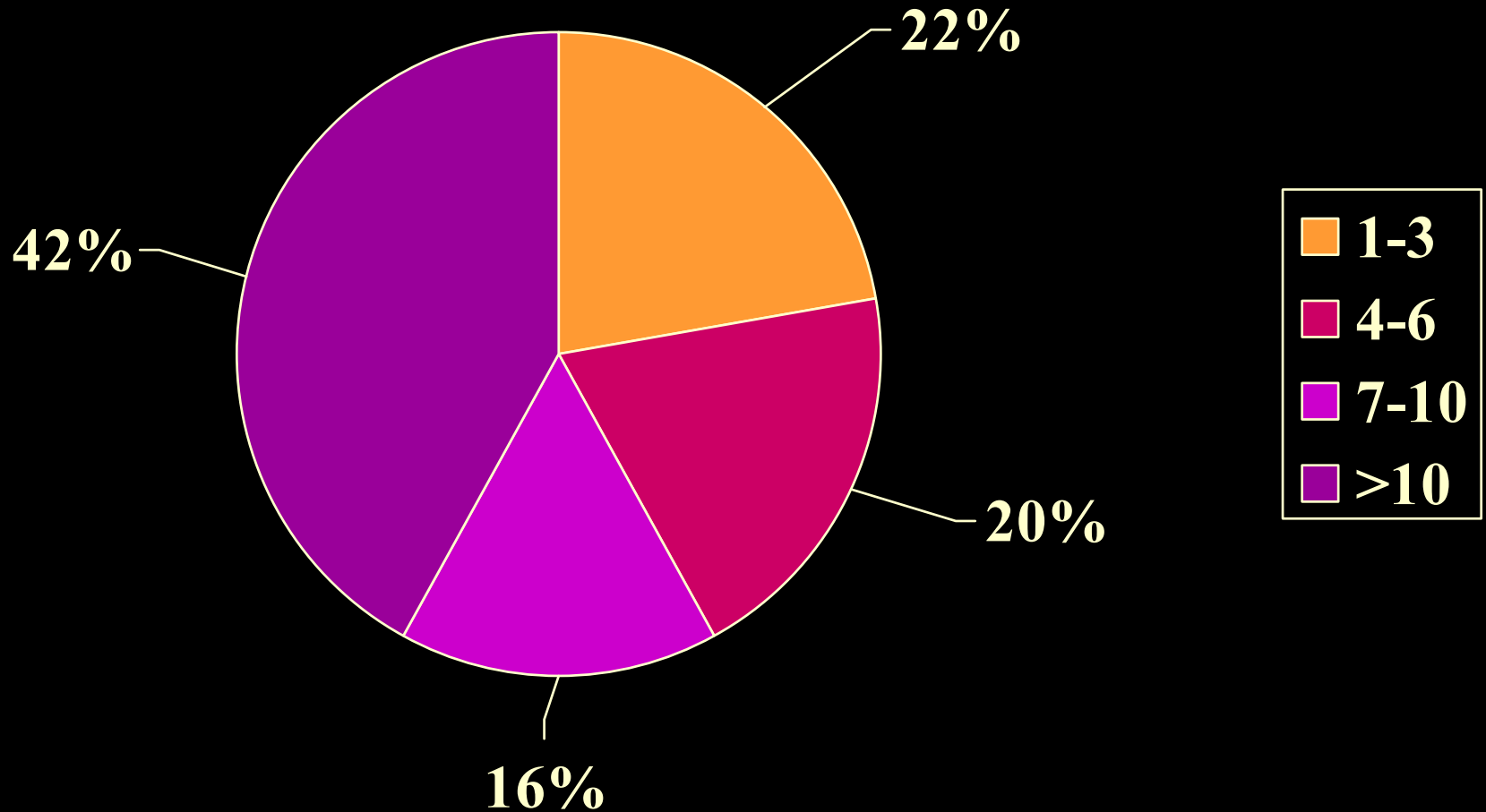

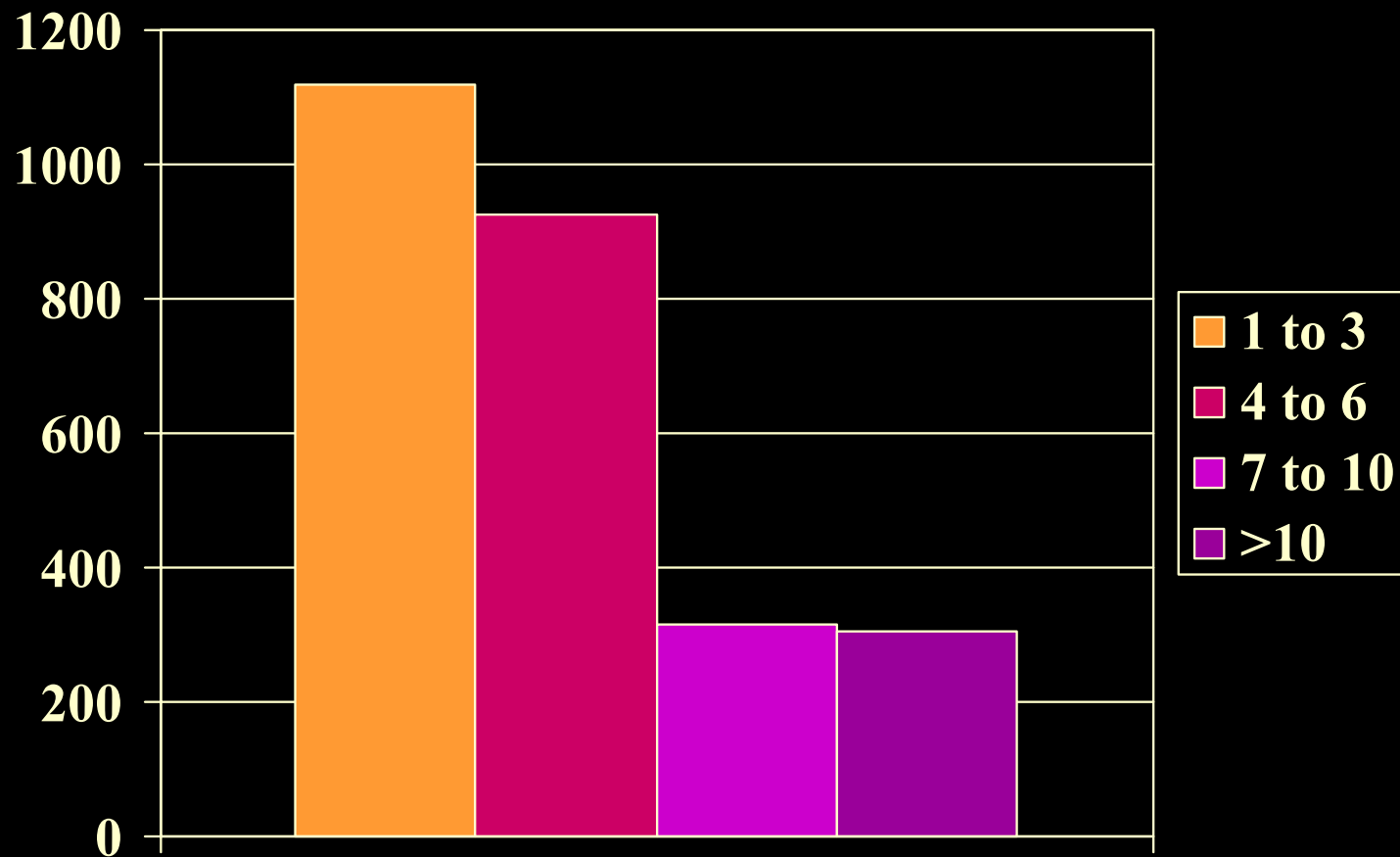
Attend Deliveries at Current Job



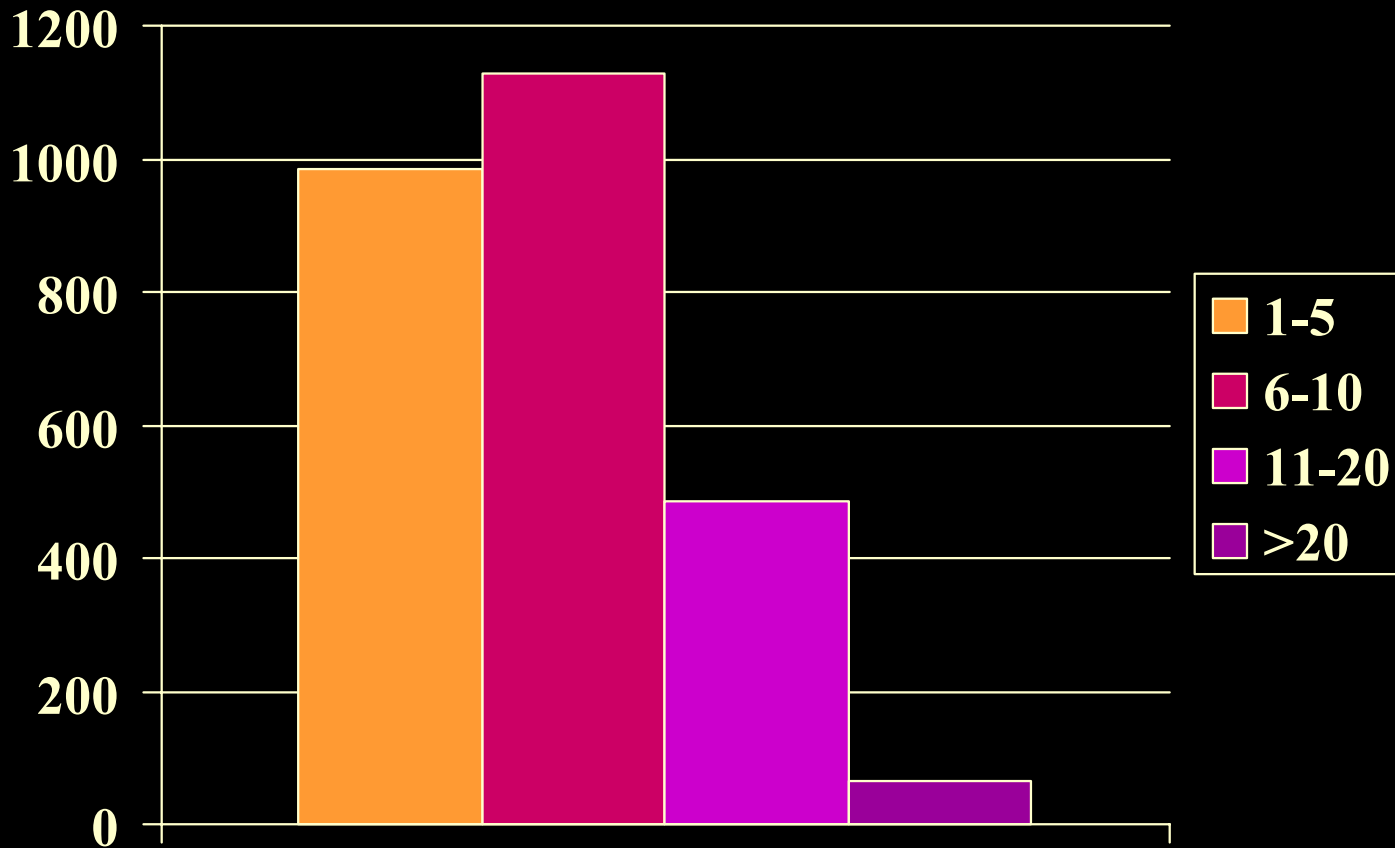
Years as an NRP Instructor



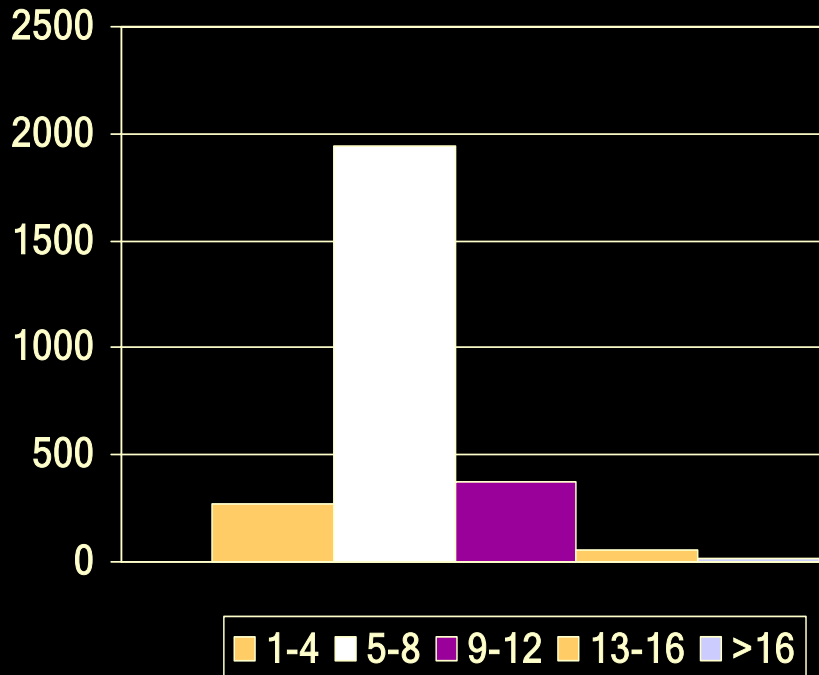
Average Number of Courses Taught Per Year



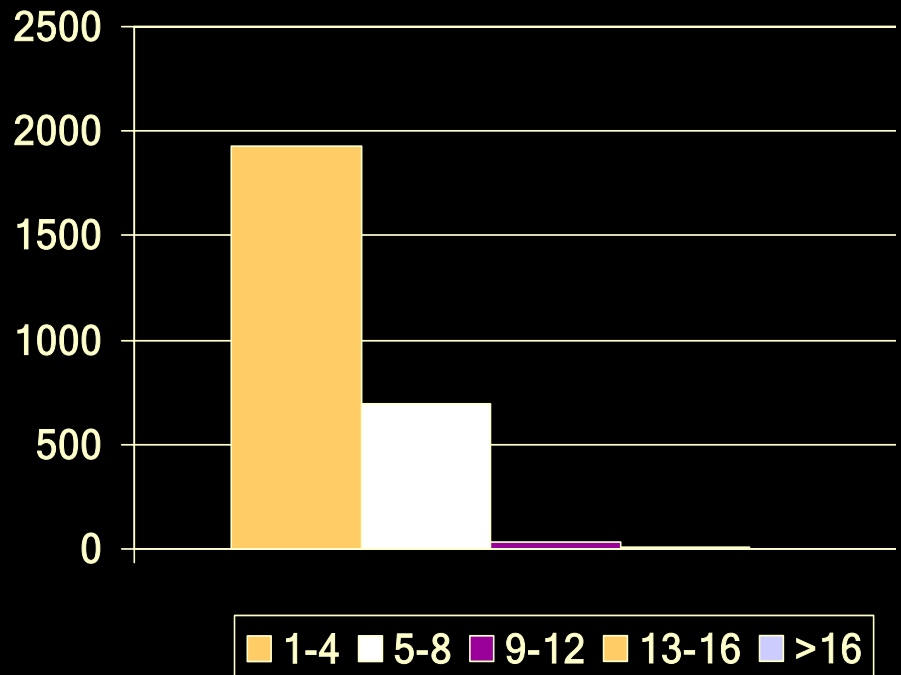
Participants in an Average Provider Course

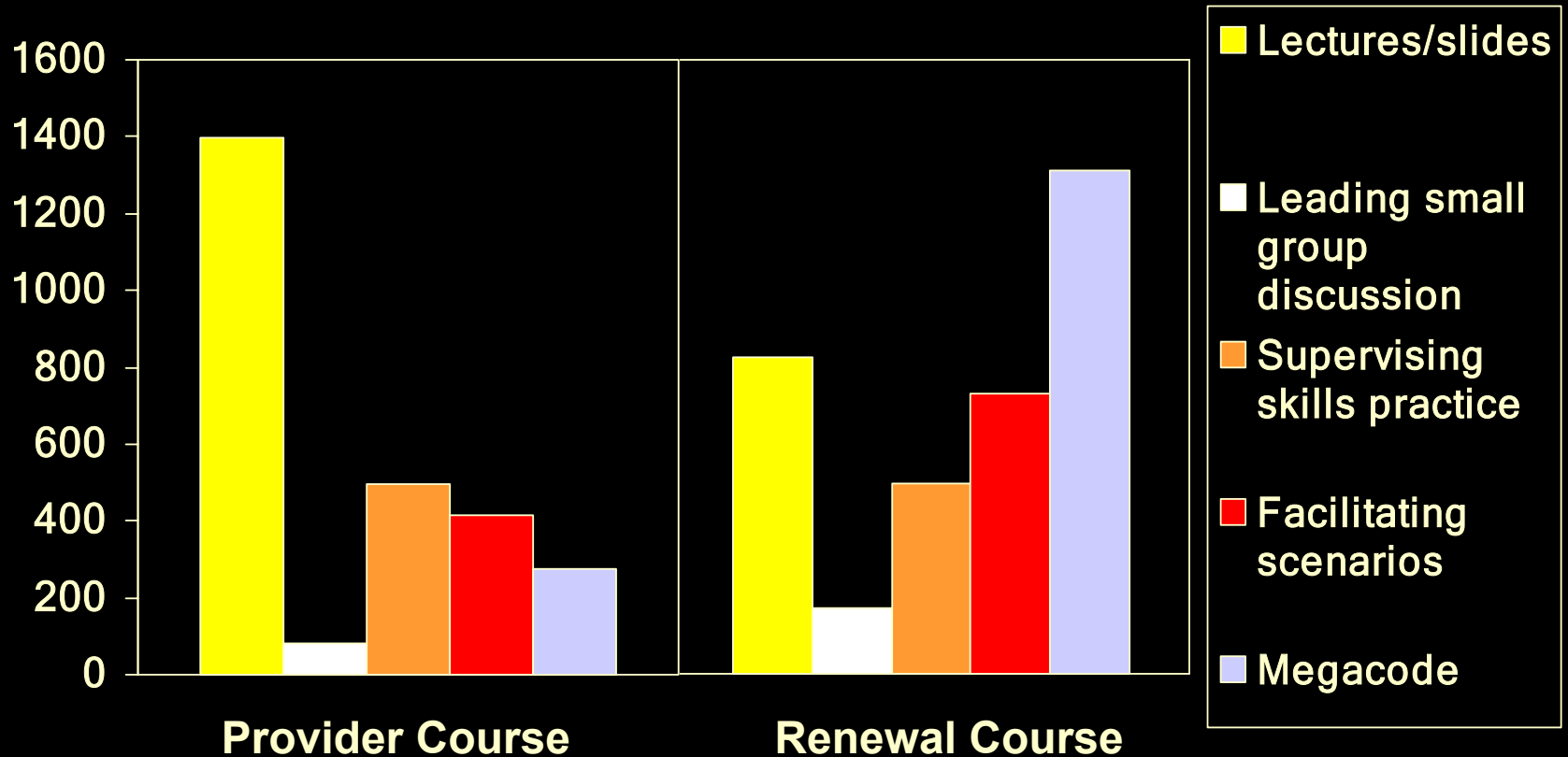

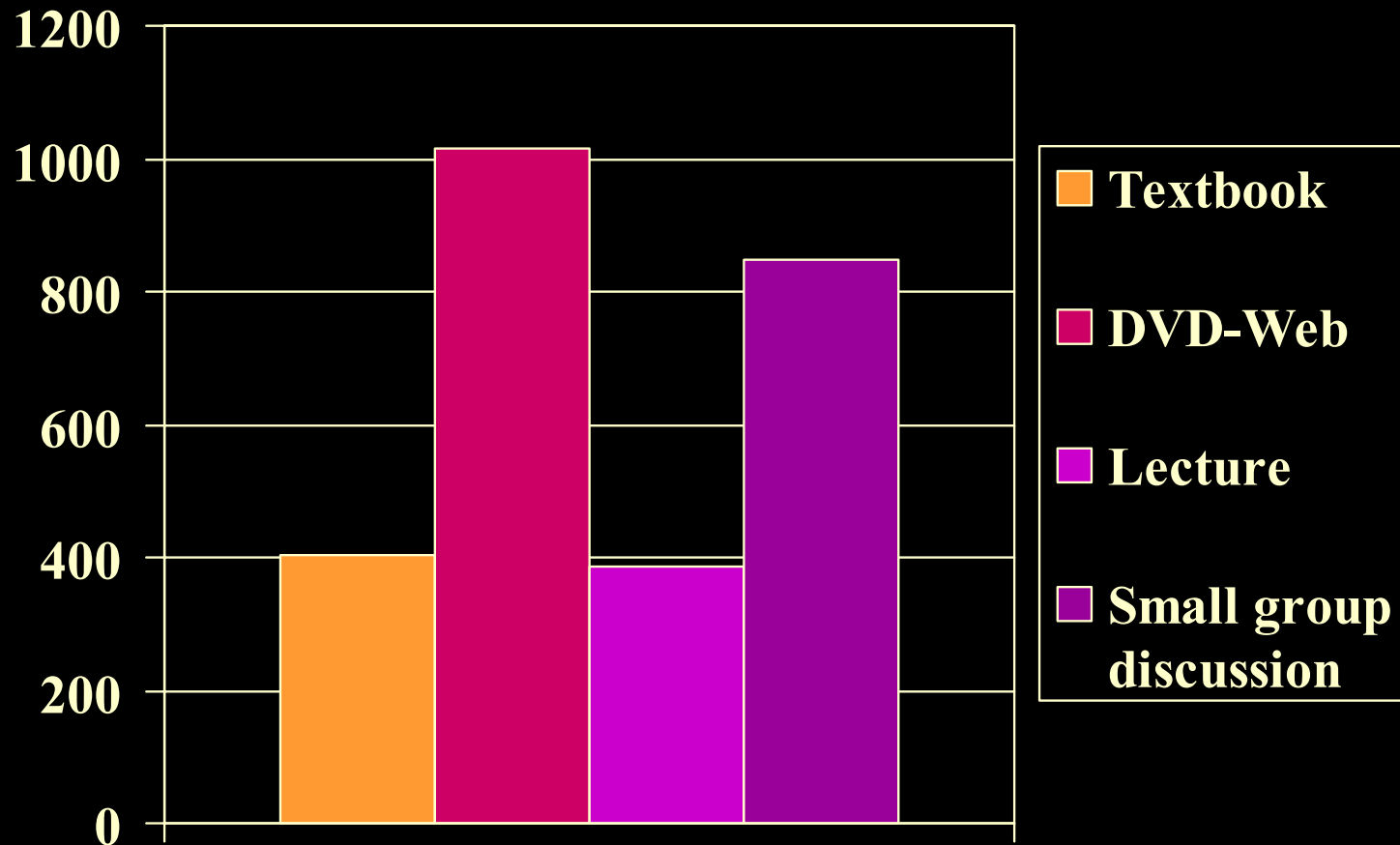

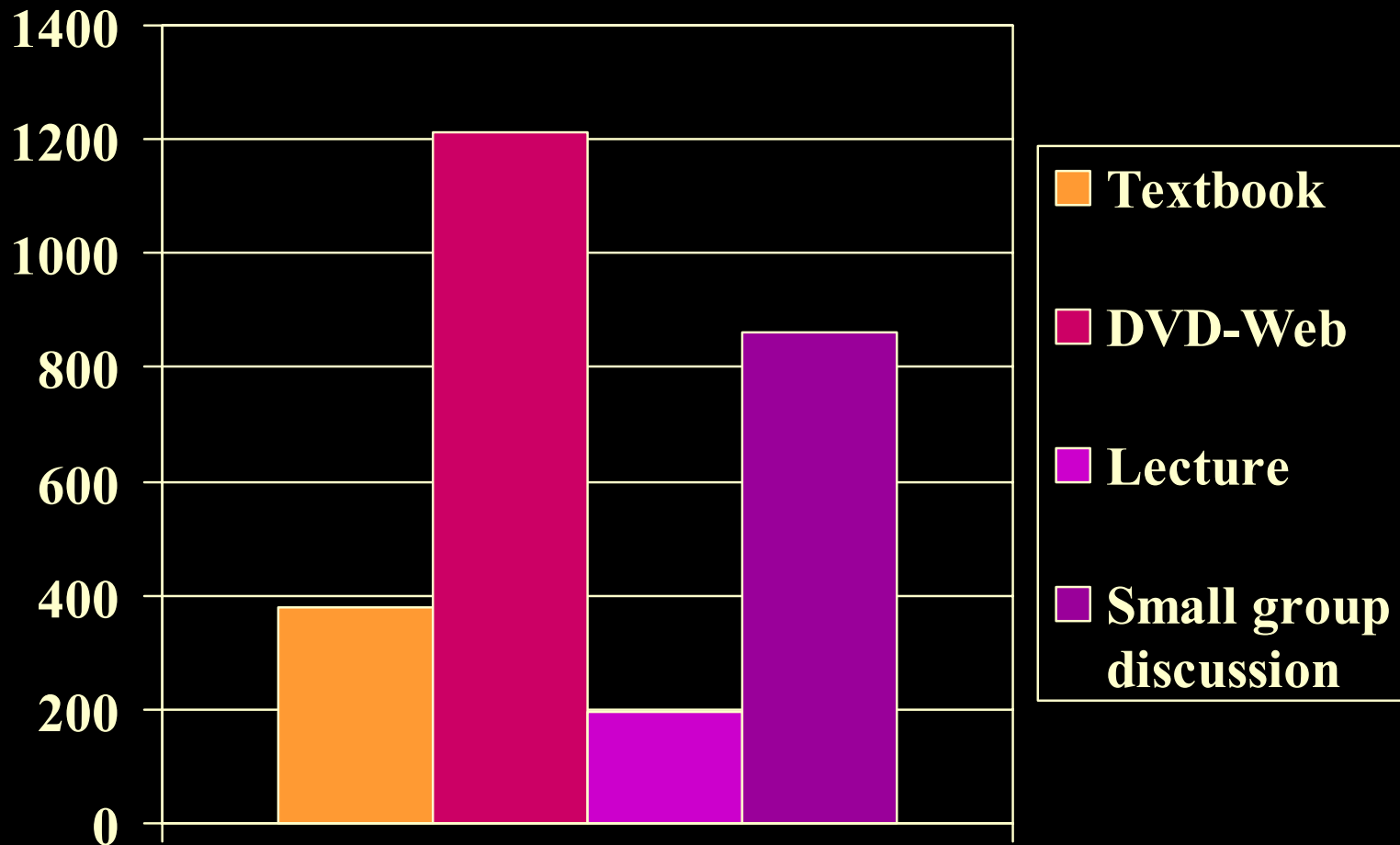
Greatest Percentage of Instructor Time



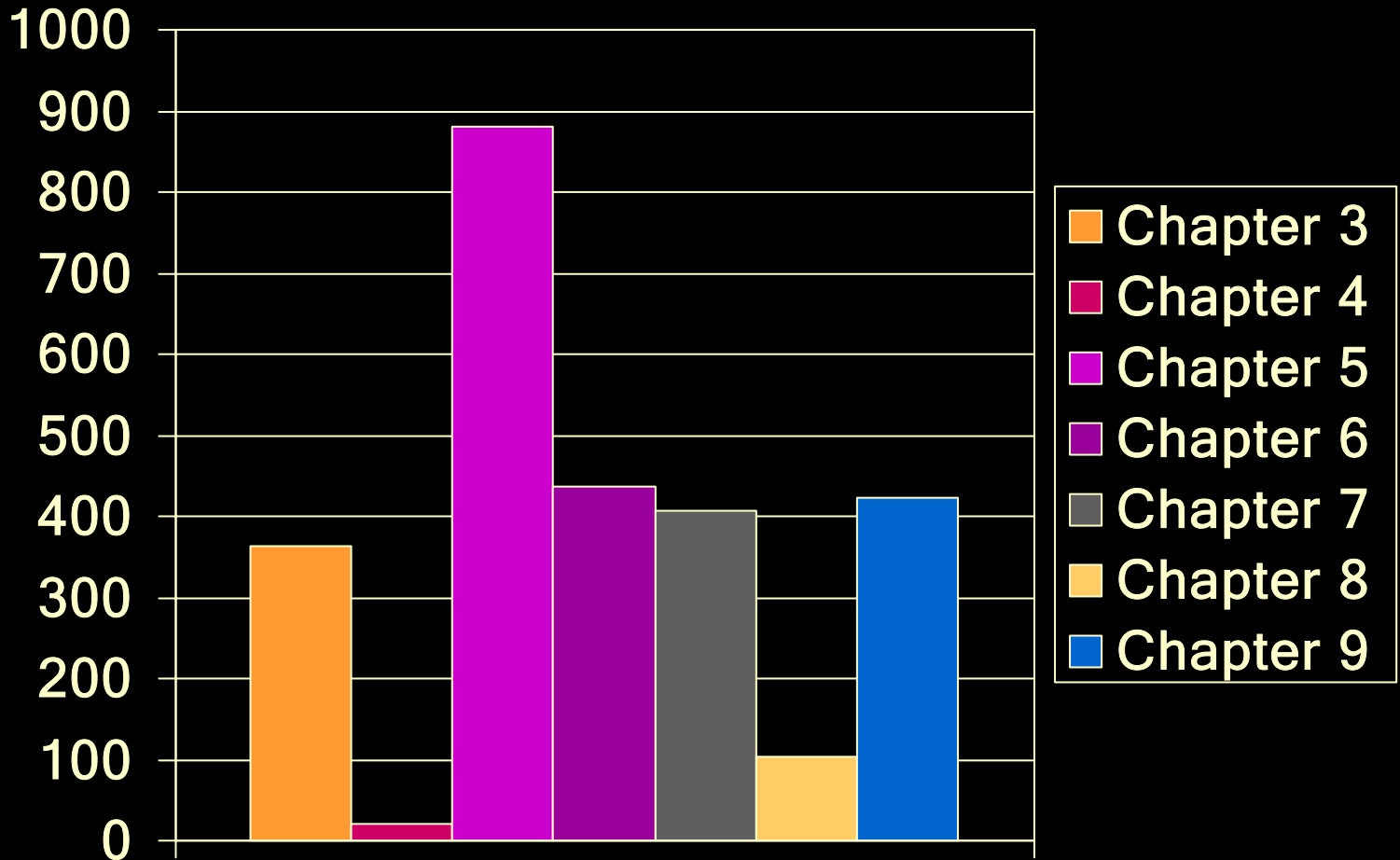
Most Effective Way for New Providers to Learn Knowledge Component



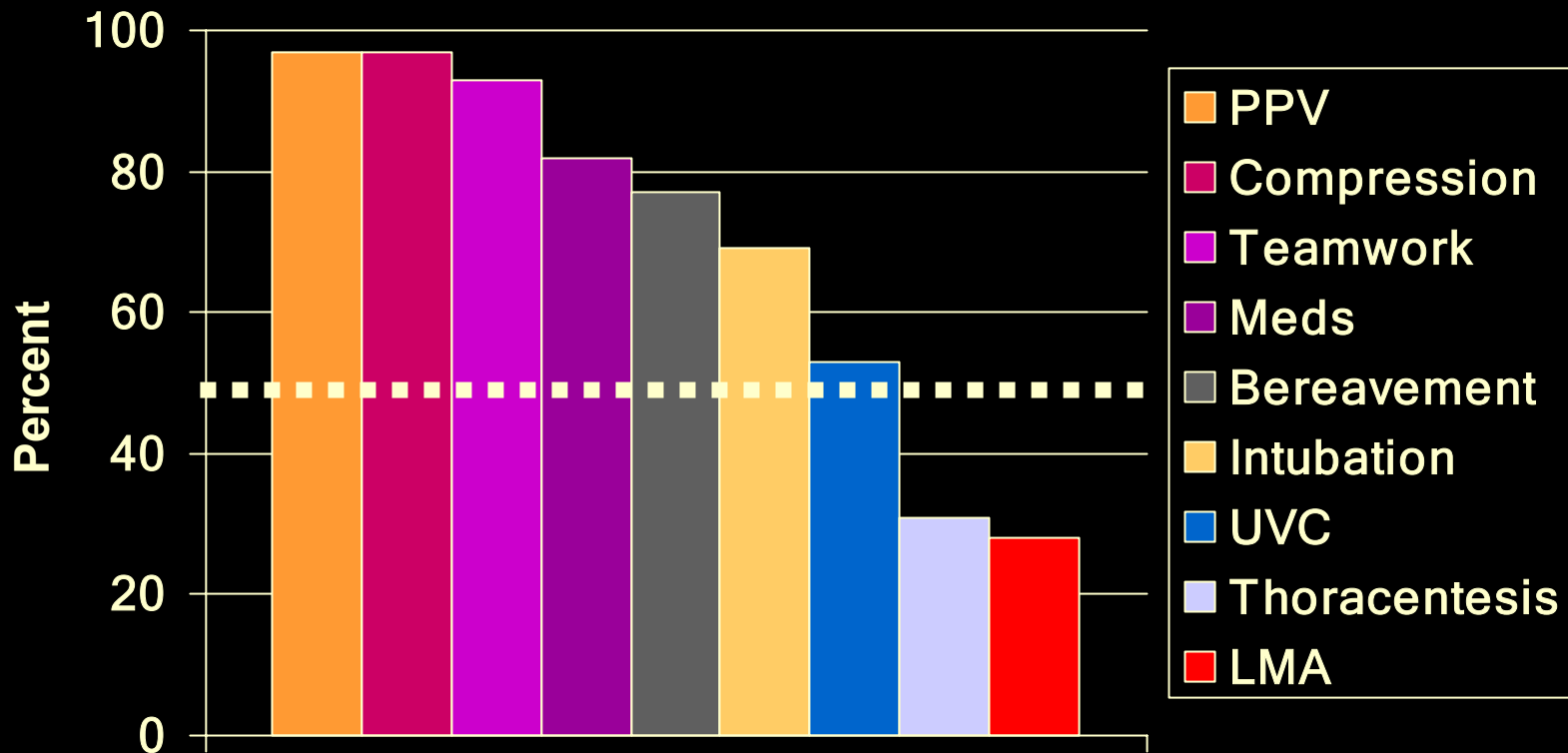
Most Effective Way for Renewing Providers to Update Knowledge



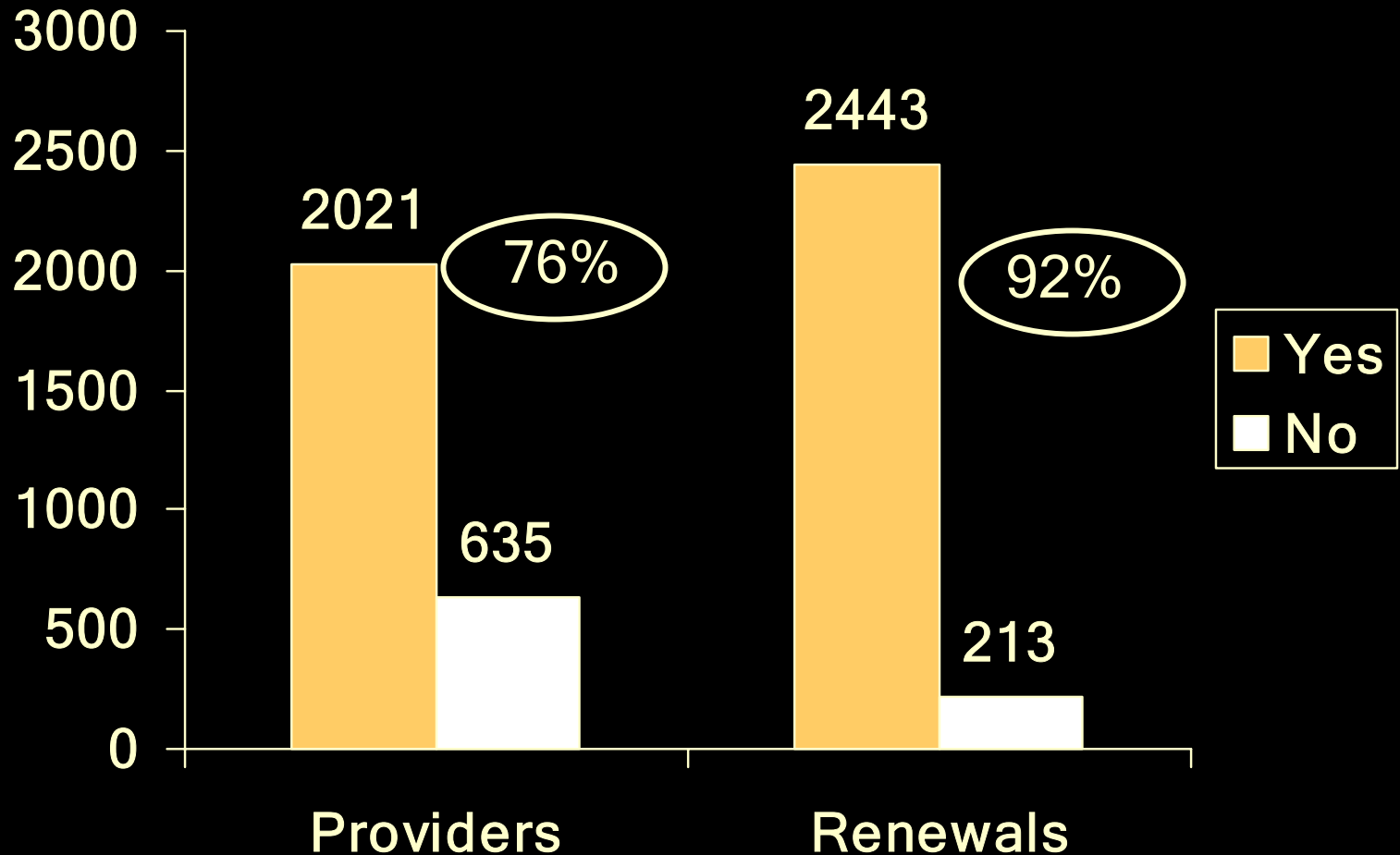
Most Difficult Lesson to Teach



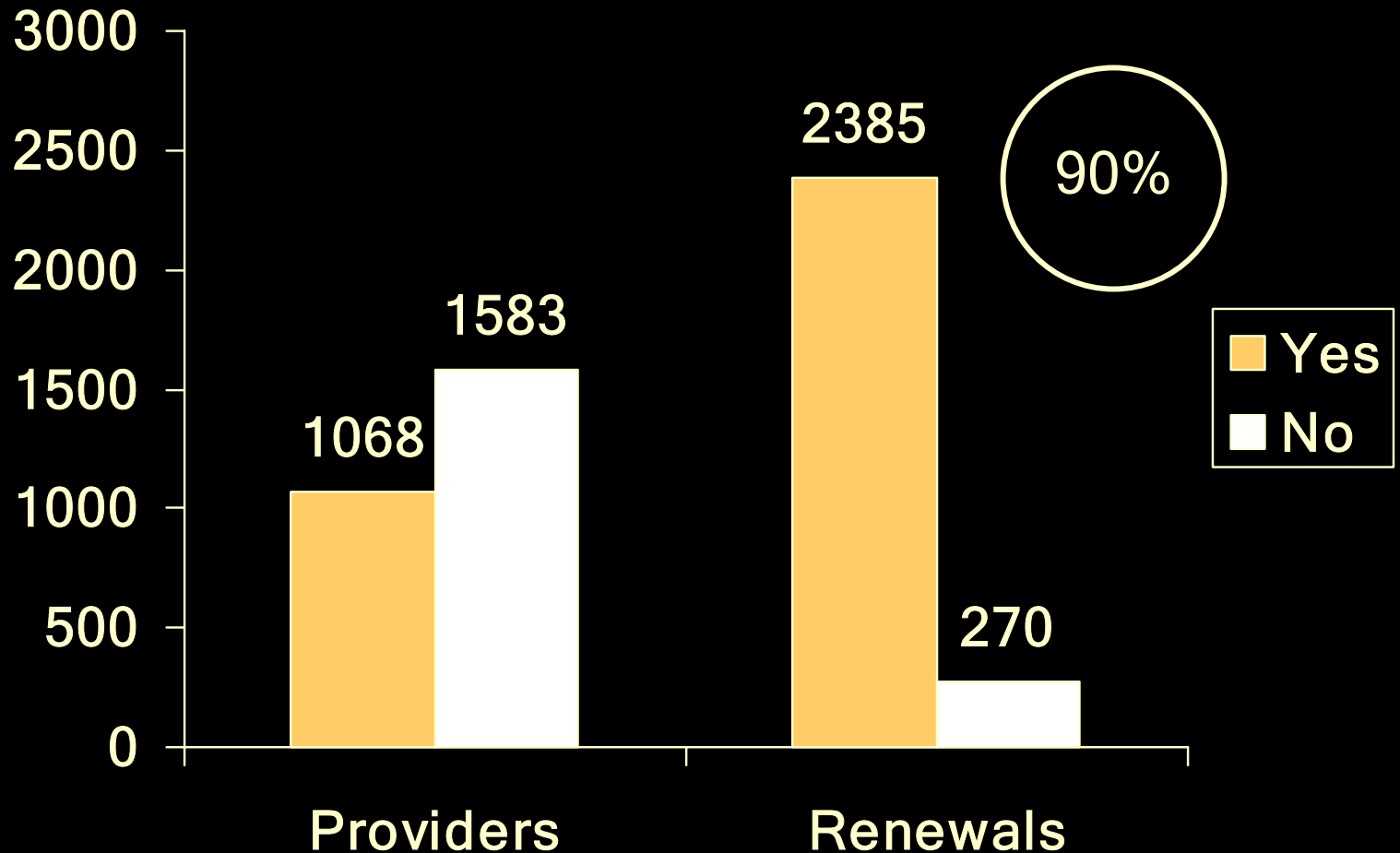
Skills I Am Comfortable Teaching



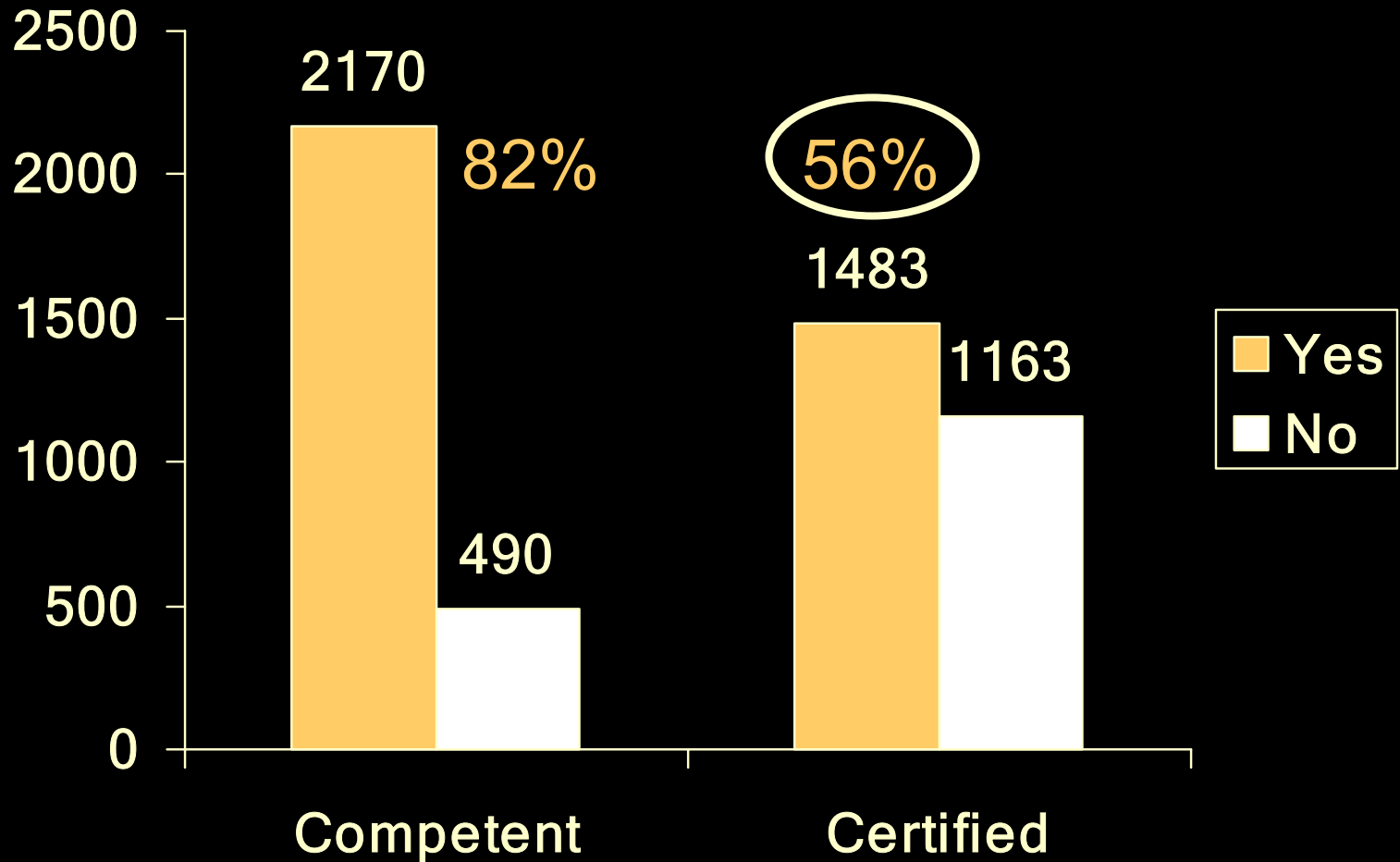
Arrive Well Prepared and Have Mastered the Knowledge Component



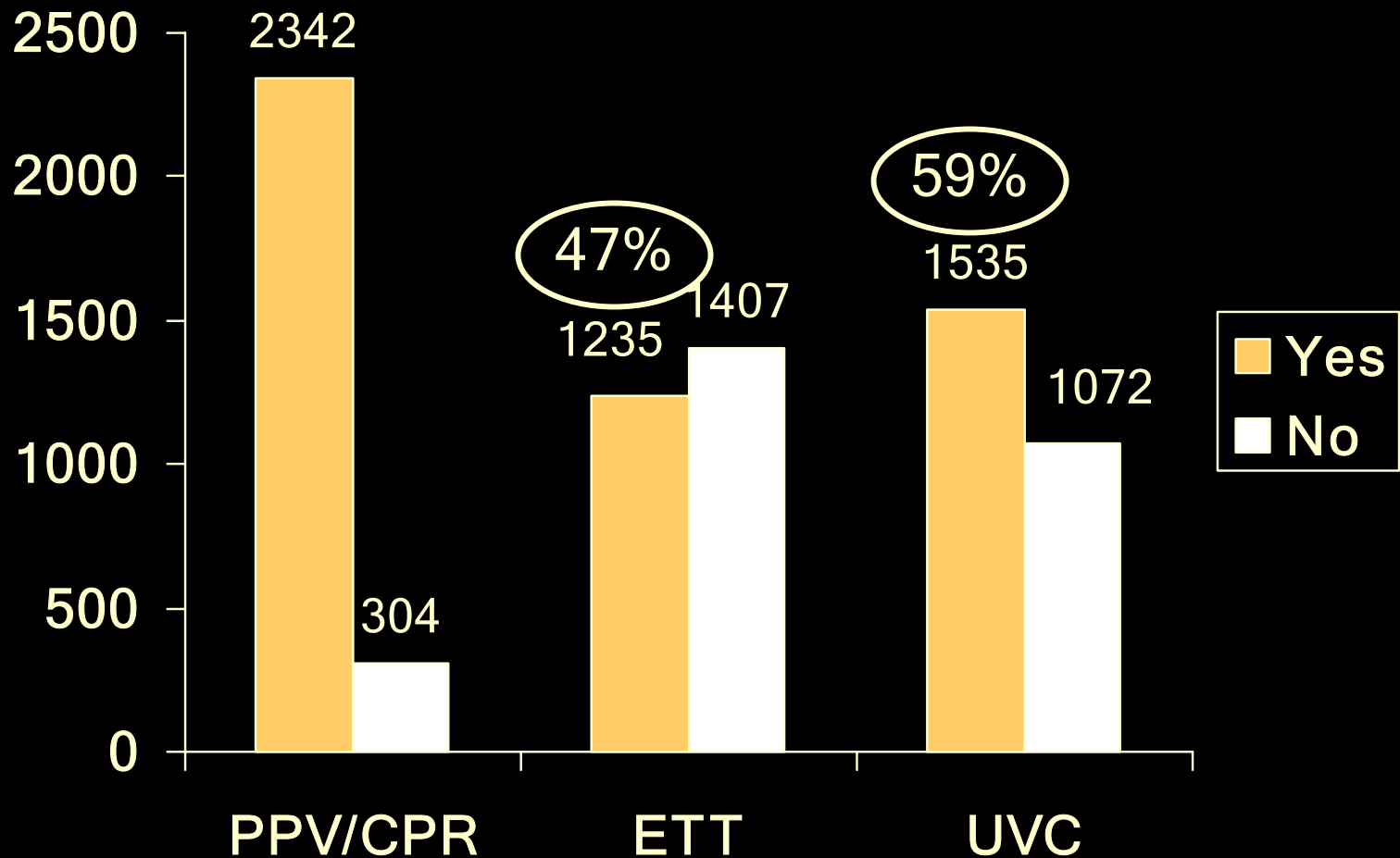
Arrive Having Mastered the Skills Components



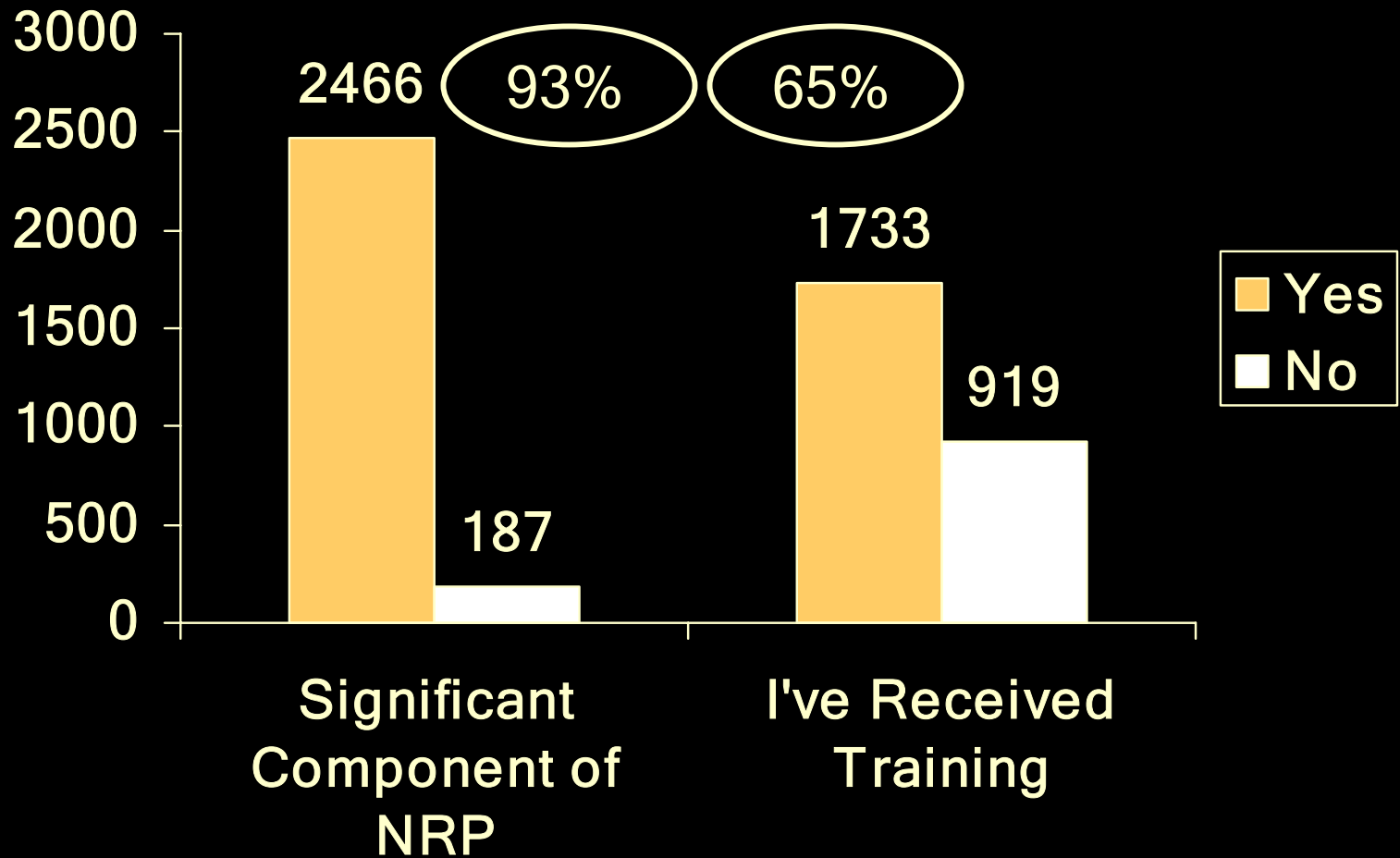

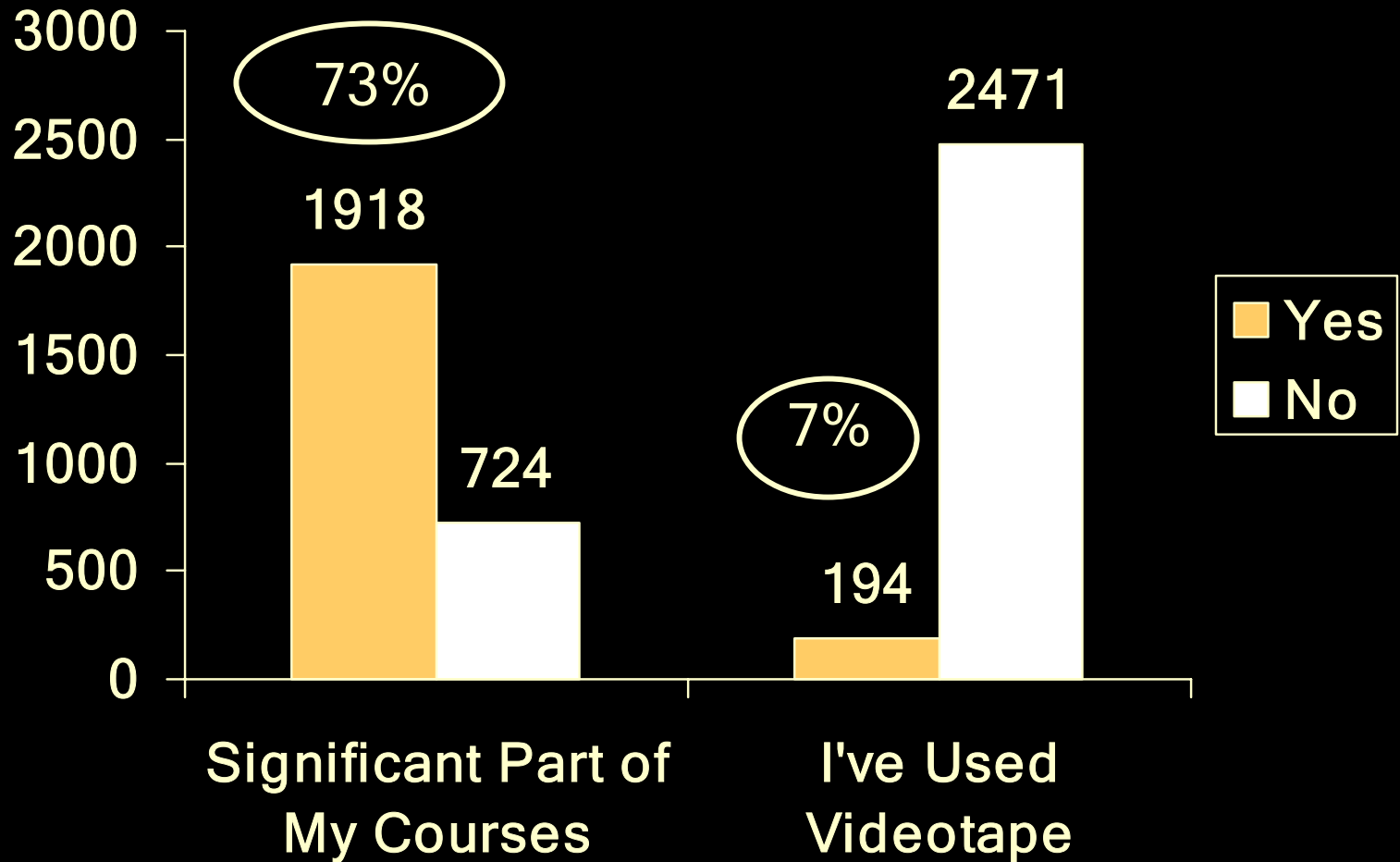

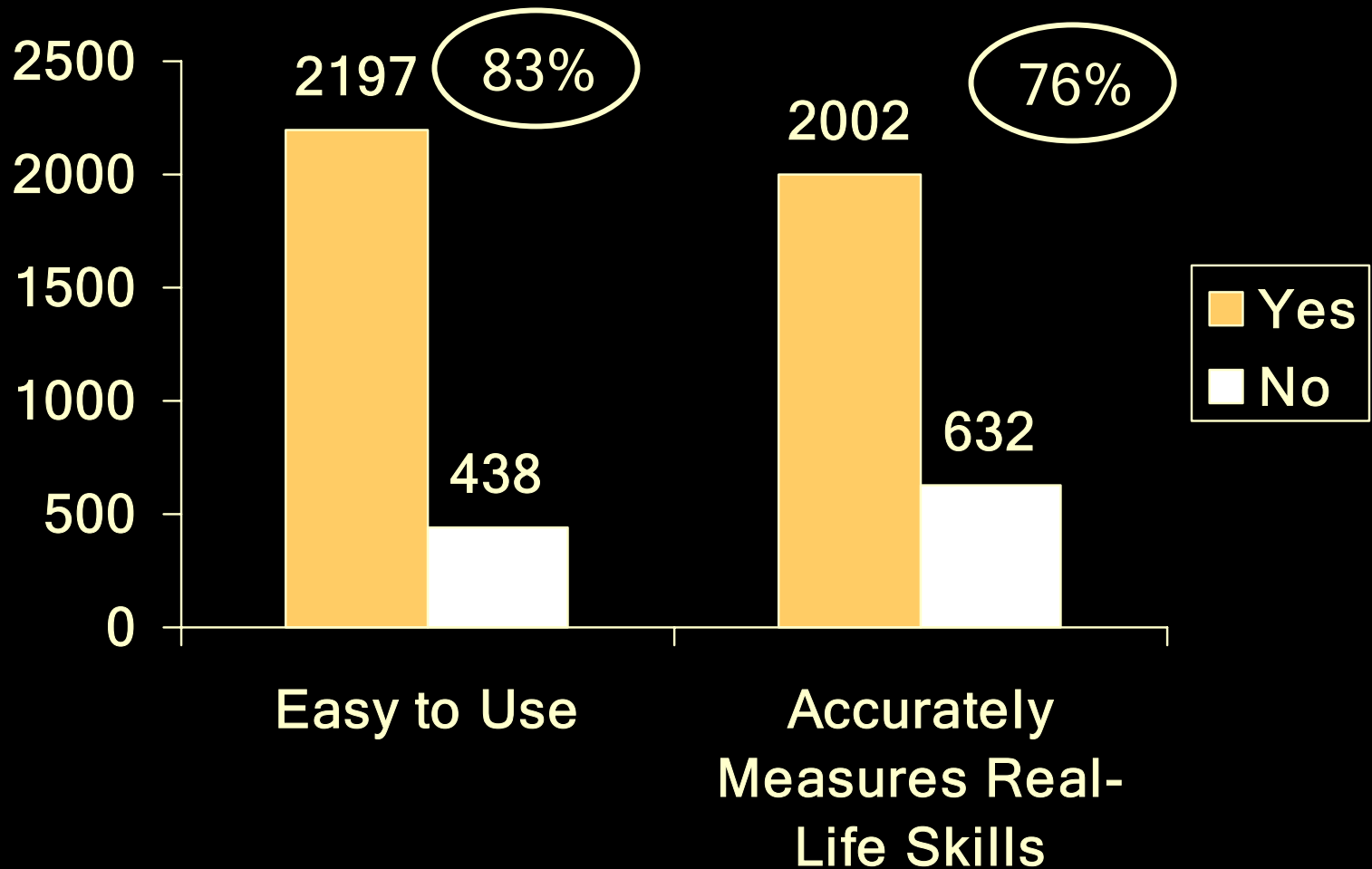

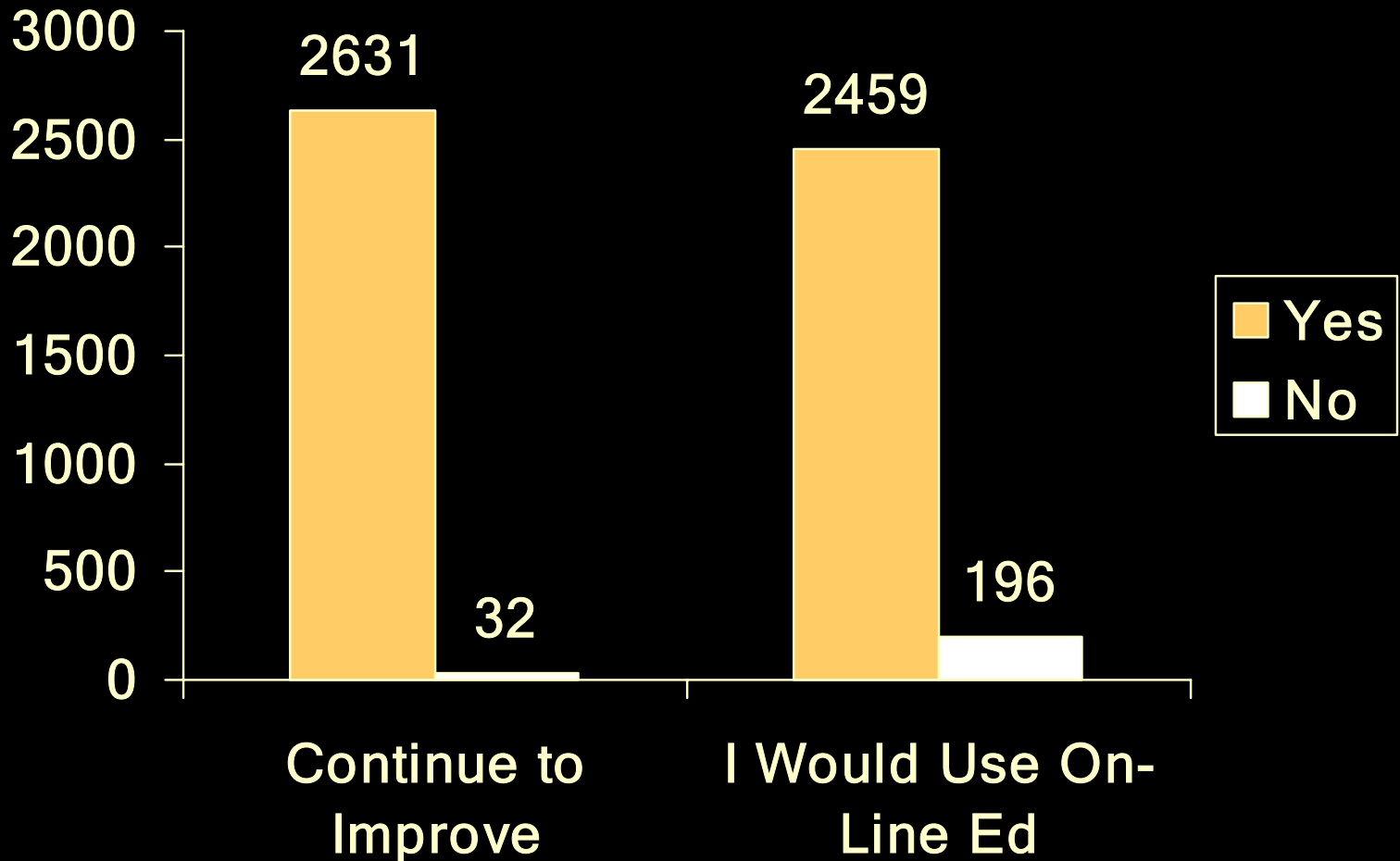
