

AAP Medicaid Reimbursement Survey, 2007/08

FINAL REPORT

April 2008

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1. Survey Summary and Caveats

As part of its effort to monitor the impact of the Medicaid program on pediatrics, the Academy (AAP) conducts its Medicaid Reimbursement Survey periodically. The Survey, which collects state-level data on Medicaid program information and state-administered fee-for-service program payment rates for most commonly reported pediatric CPT[®] (Current Procedural Terminology) codes and dental codes, is mailed to State Medicaid Directors in the 50 states and the District of Columbia.

Fees shown in this report represent fee-for-service payments reported by states for state-administered Medicaid programs only. Nationally, the majority of children enrolled in Medicaid programs are enrolled in managed care plans, which may or may not benchmark provider payment rates to fees shown in this report. Attempts by the AAP to collect plan-to-provider payment rates in Medicaid managed care plans have been unsuccessful since such information has typically been classified as “confidential and proprietary” by the states and the plans with which they contract. Depending on managed care penetration levels, the impact of state-administered fee-for-service Medicaid payment rates varies by state. Medicaid managed care penetration rate and state effort to monitor plan-to-provider payment in each state are described in a set of notes at the beginning of this report. (See 4. The most recently conducted survey, mailed initially in July 2007 with follow-up mailings, email and telephone contact through February 2008, requested payment rates effective July 1, 2007, the beginning of the 2007-08 fiscal year for most states. This report includes payment information provided by the offices of Medicaid Directors in 47 states and the District of Columbia. Data for New York and Hawaii are based on a search of the two states' Medicaid websites by AAP staff. Tennessee, which does not administer a fee-for-service Medicaid program, is not included in this report.
