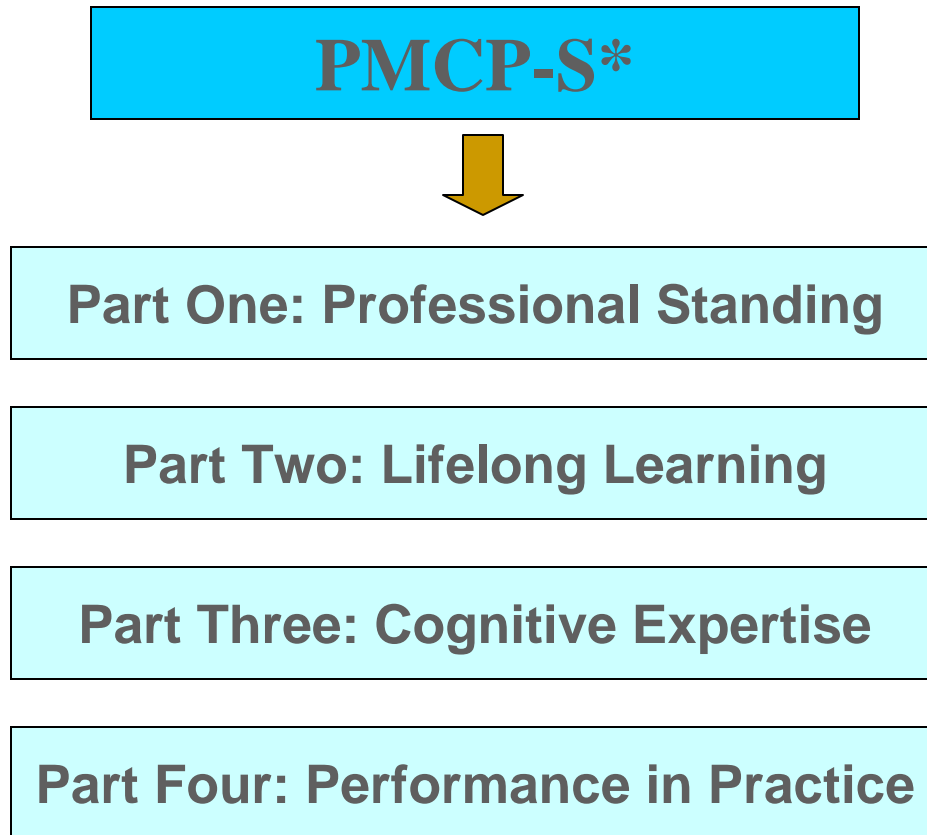

Participation in eQIPP-like module (e.g. ABMS Safety Module)*

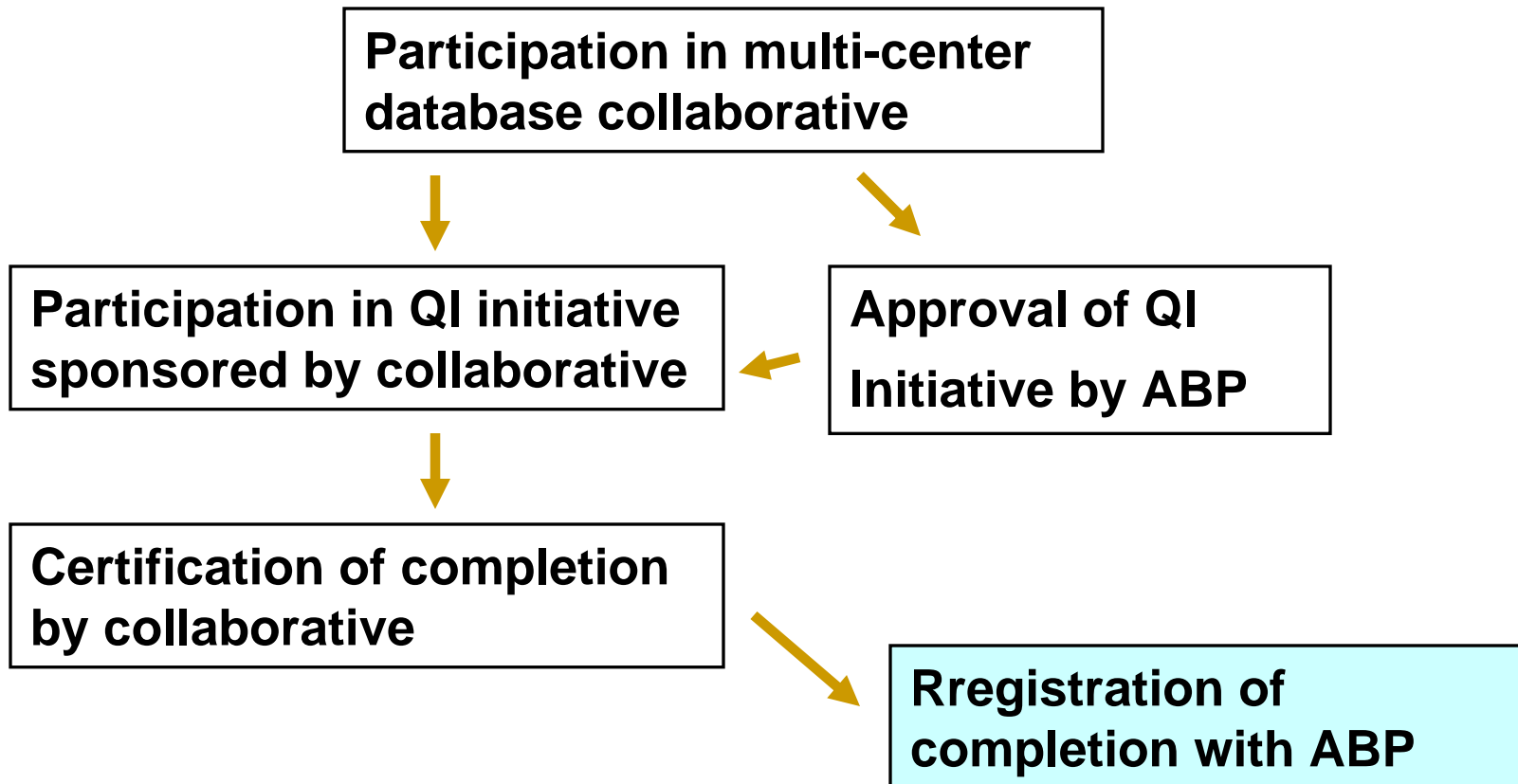
