1. If you would like to send a message to everyone on the executive committee e-mail list, the e-mail address is seniorsexec@listserv.aap.org. Keep in mind that your message will be sent to all executive committee members on the list.
2. When you reply to a message sent through the e-mail list, your reply will only be sent to the sender of the message and not to the entire e-mail list. This prevents personal, direct replies from the sender from being sent to the entire list.
3. If you would like to reply to a message sent through the e-mail list and want everyone to receive your reply, then e-mail your reply to seniorsexec@listserv.aap.org.
4. As an Executive Committee member, you are automatically added to the Executive Committee e-mail list when you are elected and removed when your term expires. This e-mail list is closed to other members, and they cannot subscribe to it.

5. If you would like to send a message to all members, please send your message to seniors@listserv.aap.org.
