The American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) has reviewed the Pediatric Hospital Medicine (PHM) petition for subspecialty status and decided to move forward. The Section will continue to keep the PHM community informed as more information develops.

1997	SHM founded (initially as National Association of Inpatient Physicians)
1998	Initial PHM Conference sponsored by Cambridge Health in Boston
1998	Initial Solicitation to AAP to form Proposed Provisional Section on Hospitalists
1998	Paul Bellet presents on Generalist Internist Service at PAS in New Orleans
1999	Provisional AAP Section founded as Section on Hospitalists~ 100 members
2001	Ambulatory Pediatric Association (APA) now known as the Academic Pediatric Association Hospital Medicine SIG founded
2002	Pediatric Research in Inpatient Settings initially founded
