PREP® (Pediatrics Review and Education Program) is the flagship self-assessment program of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Beginning at the end of January 2026, PREP Blocks will be released. Trusted PREP content will be delivered on a refreshed desktop experience and new mobile app, offering high-quality, learner-centric content for pediatric professionals.

What are PREP Blocks?

- PREP Blocks are sets of 20 case-based self-assessment questions in a specific content area.
- Each block offers up to 4 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™ and 4 MOC Part 2 Points.
- Blocks are valid for three years from release and can be purchased individually or as part of PREP Blocks Plus (see more information in the next section).
- You can mix and match blocks to focus on your learning needs.

What are PREP Blocks Plus?

- PREP Blocks Plus are PREP Blocks sold as a set or with another item (e.g. AAP Journal).
- PREP Blocks Plus may include a print component, a discount, or an AAP journal.

Who can use PREP Blocks?

- PREP Blocks are designed for all pediatric professionals, including attending physicians, nurse practitioners*, physician assistants, residents, and fellowship trainees.
 - *Select blocks are accredited for NAPNAP CE contact hours.
